- 2. The shortlisted candidates will be informed about the interview through email. Hence candidates are advised to check email for updates from time to time.
- 3. Selection of the candidate(s) will be based on the performance in Interview.
- 4. In case of large number of eligible candidates after scrutiny of applications and it is not feasible to call all the candidates for interview, the appointing authority may adopt suitable higher criteria for short listing the candidates who will be called for interview.
- 5. Candidates are advised to provide relevant and correct information while applying.
- 6. Shortlisted candidates are required to submit copy of resume with complete set of all selfattested certified copies of educational certificates/experience and photo identity along with original for verification at the time of Interview.

- 3. PI/ICMR will not be responsible, if candidate fails to submit application within prescribed date for whatever reason.
- 4. Submission of incorrect or false information during the process of interview/or Personal discussion shall disqualify the candidature at any stage.
